Connecting to the Gospel:

How did Jesus show compassion to us? Read Romans 5:6-11 and discuss.

How did Jesus show compassion to you in your testimony? Maybe it's when you first came to know Jesus, or perhaps it's in daily provisions from the Lord. Write down or share some examples.

Living out the Truth:

Rich Christians are real Christians if they are truly compassionate. How do you lack compassion in your life?
