A Faithful Witness

Ice Breaker:

Who is someone in your life who has inspired you to study Scripture more deeply?

Understanding the Context:

Re-read Acts 17:1-15. Who are the people involved? What are the responses to the gospel?

Read 1 Thessalonians 1. What was the fruit of the ministry to Thessalonica?

Connecting to the Gospel:

Read Hebrews 12:1-2. How was Jesus faithful to his mission? How does this encourage us to endure and persevere no matter what we may face?

Living out the Truth:

Acts 17:6-7 talks about Jason and the attack of his family for following Jesus and believing the Gospel. Like Jason, are you willing to stand with Christ despite any mistreatment or loss? What things are in the way?

Accountability:

How is the Spirit convicting you in regards to faithfully sharing the gospel? What type of opposition might we face that might discourage us from doing so, and how can we persevere through those things?

Parenting Moment:

Take some time to talk with your child(ren) about why sharing the Gospel is important. Ask them what they think might happen when they tell friends or family about Jesus. Remind them that no matter what, God is always with them, and sharing the Gospel is worth it. Pray together, asking God to give them the courage to share His message with someone who needs to hear it.
